Dear Parents,

The supply lists for grades K through 7 are finished and available! I know that many of you are anxious to get started and I thank you for your patience.

When you see your child's supply list for the 2008-2009 school year, please notice the following changes:

1. Items have been segmented into 4 sections:
  - a. Supplies that can be obtained from Wal-Mart, Office Max or other office supply stores.
  - b. Supplies that should be obtained from the NSA Spirit Shop during the preschool week. These items are either items that have been special ordered by the school or items that teachers want each student to have exactly the same.
  - c. Items that you can bring from home – such as an old T-shirt for art, etc.
  - d. Classroom wish list items – these items are OPTIONAL and are no longer a mandatory part of the supply list. If you would like to pick up these items when you are shopping to donate to the classroom, please feel free.
2. Estimated pricing has been added to each supply list item.

In the current economic environment, every penny counts. As the finance director, my goal is to be aware of when our parents are required to make purchases for their students and how much those purchases cost.

The costs for supplies, books, athletics can add up quickly. My job is to make sure that what you are required to buy is absolutely necessary and as affordable as possible.
