This will include exposing the students to a variety of cultures, languages and traditions. The Lower School Global Connections teacher will have significant latitude to shape the program in concert with the school's mission. This individual will be expected to hold the highest standards of educational professionalism while engaging students in the cultural and language exposure activities. This individual should be able to work in a collaborative atmosphere, while continuing to advance the current language program, and support all other programs of the school.

- Instruct global connections classes on a daily rotation at both the Main Campus and the Harbour View campuses to students in PreKindergarten through Fifth Grade.
- Plan, prepare and deliver instructional activities that facilitate active learning experiences and lead to the development of critical thinking, collaboration, communication and creativity skills.
- Identify and select different instructional resources and methods to meet students' varying needs.
- Familiarize students with the culture and history of the different countries from around the world.
- Possess specific knowledge of the structure and content of a variety of languages including the meaning and spelling of words, rules of composition and grammar.
- Work closely with classroom teachers to provide interdisciplinary opportunities whenever possible and to select programs and activities which are curricular related.
- Work with both Heads of Lower School to order all supplies, materials, and equipment necessary for language and cultural activities.
- Maintain open communication with parents, students, division heads and teachers.
- Utilize technology to facilitate instruction and enhance learning.
- Participate in divisional and whole school meetings and professional development activities.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Heads of Lower School at the Main and Harbour View campuses.
