 with all involved parties, and working with administration to create a future reciprocal exchange with
 schools in Spain.

- Bachelor's degree in Spanish or Education.
- 1–5 years of relevant teaching experience preferred with student-centered pedagogy.
- Current teaching certification in the state of Virginia, preferred, but not required.
- Technology proficiency is essential including use of Google Educational Apps and Blackbaud, and

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the use of Smart and digital projectors, preferably in an Apple environment. Proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite is preferred, but not required.
