Job Summary:

The Math Specialist in the Sandra F. Birdsong Center for Academic Excellence is responsible for providing direct instruction to students, individually or in small groups, at both the Main and Harbour View campuses, to help students to develop math skills. The Math Specialist will conduct assessments of students, analyze results, report results to parents, teachers, and students, when appropriate, and determine learning needs of students as related to the curriculum. The Math Specialist helps students learn and implement math strategies to enhance their mathematical awareness, knowledge and abilities.

Furthermore, the Math Specialist in the Sandra F. Birdsong Center for Academic Excellence is responsible for assisting in designing and leading faculty development related student math skills, assessments, etc. at both the Main and Harbour View campuses. The Math Specialist will also work closely with administration, faculty, and parents to communicate additional needs of students receiving math intervention.

Essential Functions:

- Support teachers in implementing best practices in math education.
- Lead math based professional development sessions in the Preschool and Lower School at both the Main and Harbour View campuses.
- Administer appropriate diagnostic and comprehensive testing to determine at risk students and student's weakness areas.
- Assess and review student progress on a weekly basis.
- Provide math interventions to support students' needs.
- Participate in parent conferences as needed.
- Work collaboratively with students, parents, teachers, and administrators to contribute to the overall educational experience of students of a wide range of abilities.
- Take part in professional development sessions that apply to the position.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
